If you receive per capita distribution, it is considered income. It must be counted in the month in which you receive it. If you think the amount puts you over income for August, call us and we will tell you if you are still eligible.

If you have a child in your household who is a Siletz Tribal member and that child receives the lump sum distribution, that too must be counted as a resource in the household unless the money is deposited into a college education fund. In that case, you must provide documentation that shows the account deposit.

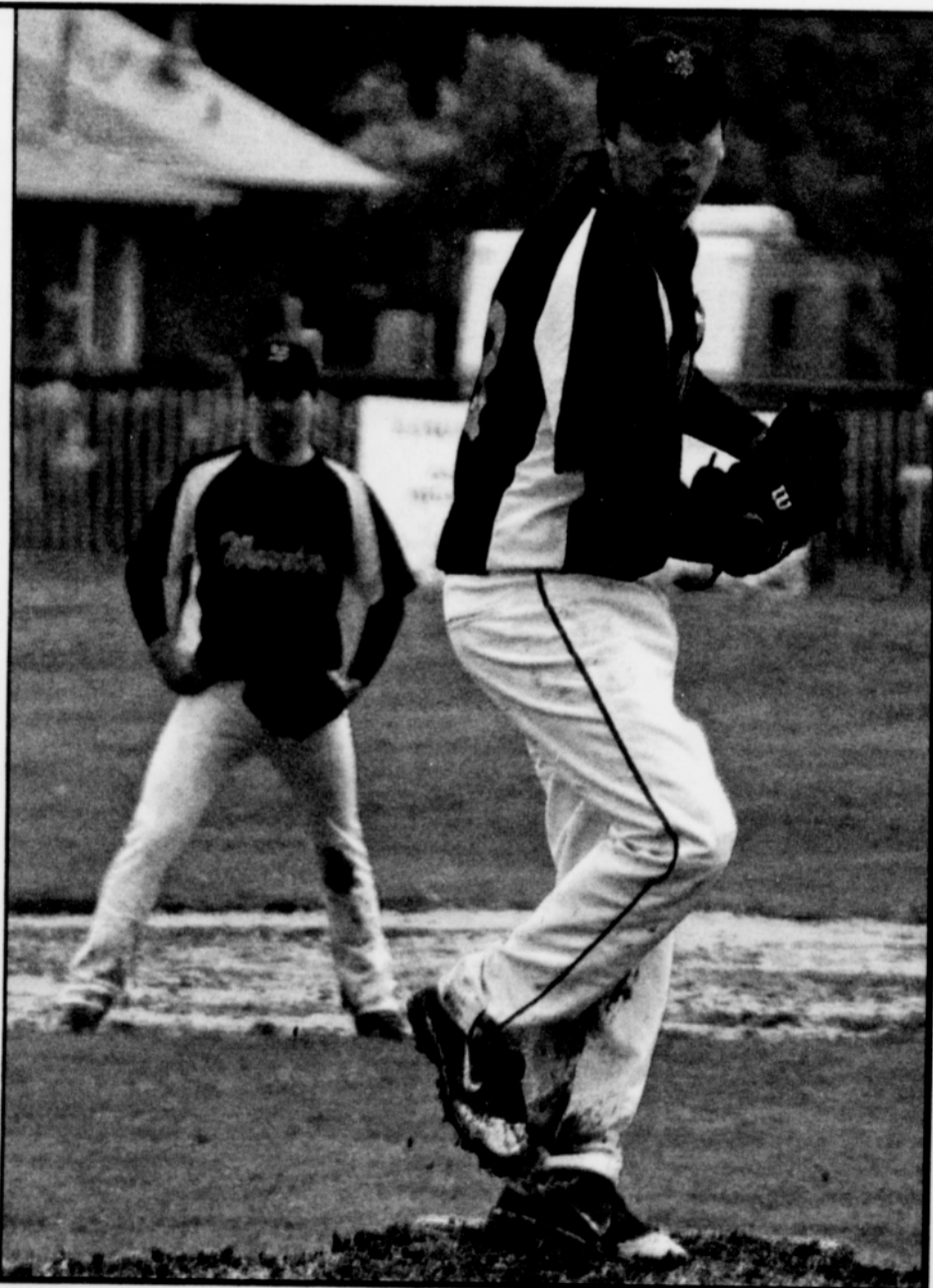
Brother represented the Warriors with heart, playing first base for the West team and helping it win two of three games.
