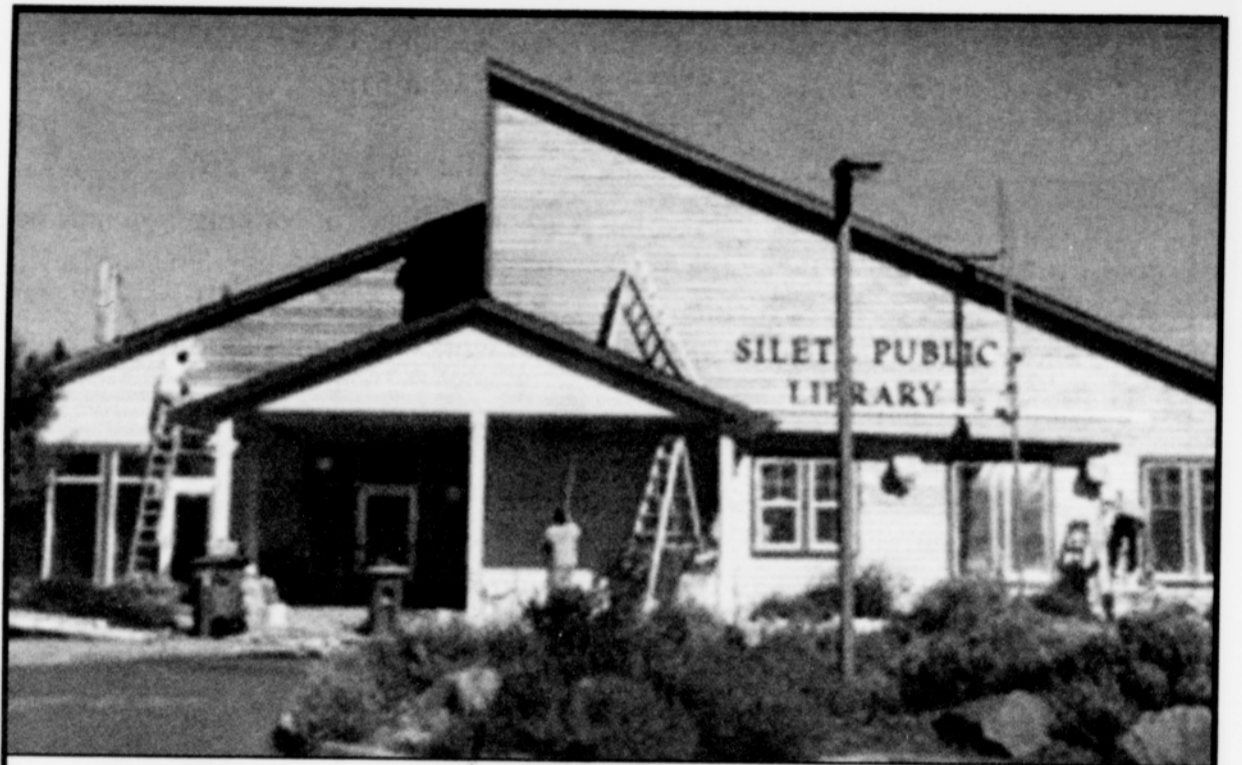
STAHS meetings are held the first Saturday of every month and are open to the public.
