

ONABEN calls for artwork for conference, trade show

ONABEN-A Native American Business Network is seeking American Indian, Alaskan Native or Native Hawaiian artwork to use in the marketing materials for the 12th Annual Trading at the River Conference and Trade Show.

At the core of this event are three elements: Native people, growth and trade. From its inception, Trading at the River has embraced these facets to bring the event mission to life – to celebrate and grow Native American small businesses.

ONABEN has issued a call for art that in some way speaks to these three elements. The winning piece will be used in event graphics and marketing materials (website, posters, brochures, etc.).

The winning artist will be highlighted in the event program and via social media and marketing materials. The chosen artist also may have an opportunity to speak at the conference.

The deadline for submissions is 5 p.m. on Oct. 31, 2013.

All art must be original and appropriate for conversion to a digital format. More than one piece of art from any artist will be accepted. All mediums are welcome: digital art, photos, paint, textile, etc.

Please include a one-page biography, contact information and the artwork (high resolution JPGs with a max 5MB for initial submission – provide titles and descriptions). Once the art has been chosen, a use agreement and modest compensation will be offered.
