

Temporary Tribal Student Assistance Program helps with housing costs

The Siletz Tribal Housing Department's Temporary Tribal Student Assistance Program (TTSAP) will accept applications for the 2016-2017 academic year from April 1, 2016, to May 2, 2016.

Program Information

- ❖ TTSAP assists Tribal students who will attend a college, university, vocational or trade school.
- ❖ TTSAP is a time-limited program. Funding is for one academic year.
- ❖ TTSAP assists students with rent or room and board in a dormitory.

- ❖ The student's share of the rent is 30 percent of his or her adjusted annual income. Important note: The student might be required to remit a portion of the rent. For example, if a student is working, the wages will affect the student's share of the rent.
- ❖ Assistance is not transferable.

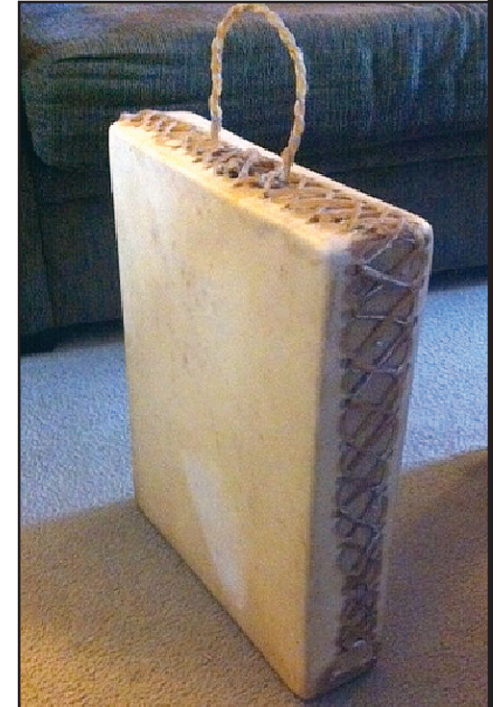

Fried Cabbage, Bacon, Onion and Chicken

- 6 slices of bacon, chopped
- 1 large onion, sliced
- 2 cloves garlic, minced
- 2 cups chicken chunks
- 1 large head of cabbage, cored and sliced
- Salt to taste
- Pepper to taste
- 1/8 teaspoon paprika
- 1/2 teaspoon garlic powder
- 1/4 cup soy sauce

This is such a tasty dish. I ended up using four heads of cabbage because people ate it as fast as I could make it.

Place the bacon in a large stockpot and cook over medium-high heat until crispy, about 10 minutes. Add onion and garlic; cook and stir until onion caramelizes, about 10 minutes.

Add chicken chunks. Immediately stir in the cabbage and continue to cook and stir another 10 minutes.

Season with salt, pepper, paprika and garlic powder. Reduce heat to low, cover and simmer, stirring occasionally, about 30 minutes. Serve as a side dish or over rice.
