

2024 Elk Tag Drawing Info

A drawing for the Tribe's antlerless elk winter-season tags will be held Monday, Nov. 4, at the Natural Resources Committee meeting.

Applications are available starting Oct. 1 and are **due Oct. 25** in the Natural Resources office. This year we have 59 tags for a winter season cow hunt using any legal weapon from Dec. 1, 2024, through March 31, 2025 (dates will vary by unit).

You can apply online via the Tribe's website (Services and Programs/Natural Resources/Fish & Wildlife) or applications can be downloaded from the website, picked up at the main Tribal administration building, or they can be mailed to you by calling the Natural Resources office at 541-444-8245.

The Pow-Wow Committee is now accepting Royalty crown proposals for 2025-2026 Royalty crowns. Proposals are being accepted for Miss Siletz, Junior Miss Siletz and Little Miss Siletz.

Proposals for a crown are required to include art design, size of the crown and a bid for the crown or crowns of your interest. Proposals can be submitted for individual crowns, two crowns or you can submit a bid for all three crowns.

Tribal Childcare Assistance Program Child Count Survey

The Tribal Childcare Assistance Program must conduct a child count every two years to develop an unduplicated count of the number of children who might be eligible for assistance through our program. The child count will determine the amount of funding the Tribal Childcare Assistance Program will qualify for. These funds are used to provide assistance to Tribal families to pay for the cost of their child care.

The Tribal Childcare Assistance Program needs your help to identify the number of children who are descendants or dependents living in Siletz Tribal households within the Tribe's 11-county service area.

If you have children living in your household who are Siletz Tribal descendants or who are the dependent of an enrolled member of Siletz Tribe, please complete the survey. 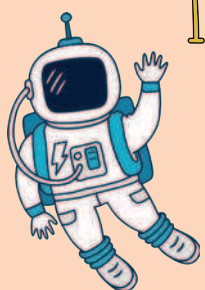
