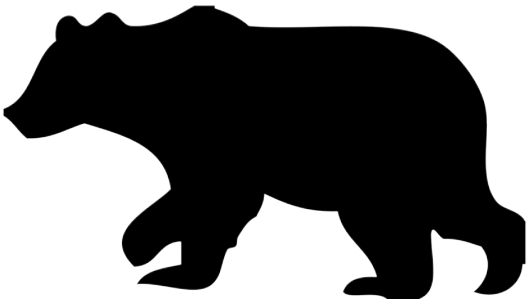


Bear paws from Natural Resources, available for a limited time

Temporary Tribal Student Assistance Program to begin accepting applications



The Siletz Tribal Housing Department's Temporary Tribal Student Assistance Program (TTSAP) will be accepting applications for the 2025-2026 academic year beginning May 1, 2025.

Program Information:

- The TTSAP assists Tribal Students who will be attending a college, university, vocational or trade school.
- The TTSAP is a time-limited program. Funding is for one academic year.

- The TTSAP assists students with rent or room fees in a dormitory.
- The student's share of the rent is thirty percent of their adjusted annual income. Important

Note: The student will be required to remit a portion of the rent. For example, if a student is working the wages will affect the student's share of the rent.

STHD will be accepting applications May 1 - 31, 2025. If applications are received after May 31, 2025 they will not be accepted by the Siletz Tribal Housing Department.
