Gubernatorial candidate Kevin Mannix has signed the Oregon School Employees Association's (OSEA) pledge requiring the Legislature to solve Oregon's long-term school funding problem during the 2003 legislative session.

Mannix is the only gubernatorial candidate to sign the pledge, according to an announcement. His Democratic opponent Ted Kulon-goski, did not respond to OSEA's request, it added.

Steven Araujo, OSEA executive director, said that Mannix committed to use "all the means at my disposal as governor to support and lead the Legislature in its effort to solve the lack of long-term, sustainable funding for Oregon's public schools during the 2003 regular legislative session."

"We can solve our school funding crisis without raising personal income or business taxes," Mannix said. "My ad-
