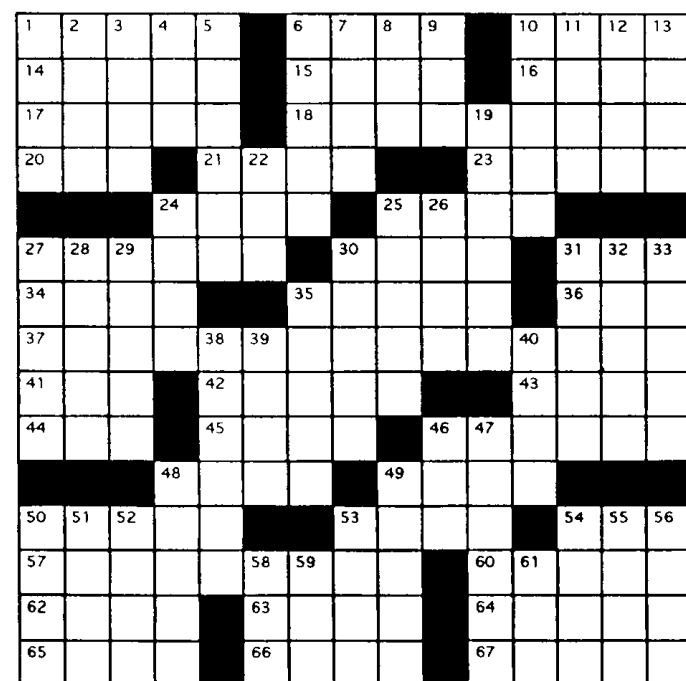

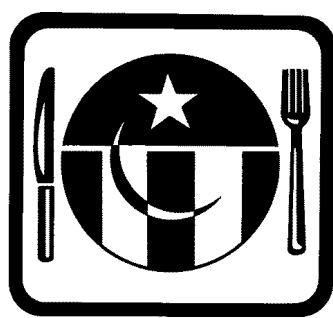

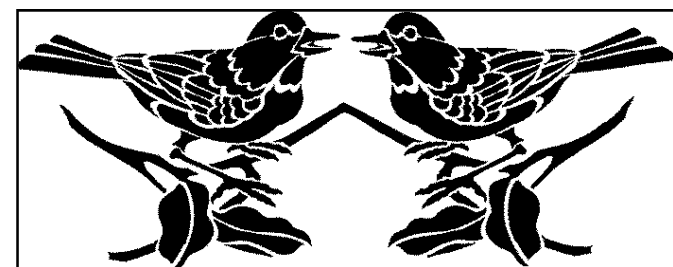
Whether you realize it or not, each man's life touches another in very profound ways. Everything you do has a ripple effect, washing over those in its path.

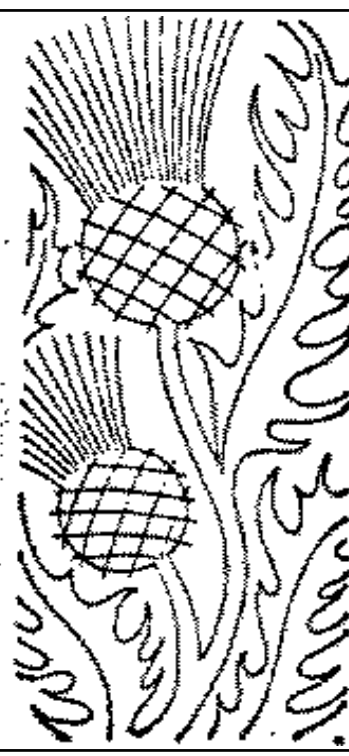
