



Teen-age pregnancies down

Oregon's teen-age pregnancy rate continued its downward trend last year, according to new data released by public health officials in the Oregon Dept. of Human Services (DHS).

"In the past 10 years teenage pregnancies have decreased by more than a third, so we've made good progress," said Sue Abrams, teen pregnancy prevention coordinator in DHS

"The Governor's Action Agenda, unveiled in 1997, laid out a multifaceted plan and called for coordinating prevention efforts, local and at the state level.


"It's made a difference," said Abrams, "along with the fact that teens are making responsible choices more often."

This is the sixth year of decline for pregnancies to those 15 to 17, and the fourth year for those 18 and 19.

"However," said Abrams, "the fact remains that there were 66 births and 56 abortions to girls between 10 and 14. We still have work to do."


