RCC offers courses to help succeed in small business

Beginning the week of Jan. 20, Rogue Community College Small Business Development Center (SBDC) will offer the following business-related courses:

"Home Business-Your Successful Start" includes calculating start-up costs, business structure, sources of supply, and financing basics. This course will be held 6 to 8:30 p.m. on Tuesday, Jan. 21. There is a fee. The instructor is Donna Love of SBDC.

"Your Business Plan-Roadmap to Success" explains how to develop a business plan and chart a course to business success. It includes business plan basics, and a marketing and financial plan.

Those enrolled also will have access to the RCC SBDC computer lab, and will use Word and Excel. The 15hour course will be held from 6 to 9 p.m. beginning Wednesday, Jan. 22 until Feb. 19. There is a fee, and the instructor is Marc Graton.

"Taking Charge: Making Decisions and Solving Problems" teaches students how to effectively make decisions and solve problems. This course will be held from 6 to 8:30 p.m. on Thursday, Jan. 23. There is a fee, and the instructor is Love.

"Oregon's Economy and Your Bottom Line" will show how using Oregon's Labor Market Information System can improve a business. Students will learn how to locate current industry trends and information on the local economy and workforce for writing a business plan, applying for grants or planning expan-






