In addition to his wife, he is survived by two sons, Jerry Robinson, of Cave Junction, and Larry Robinson, of Roseburg, a daughter, Kitty Waud, of Cave Junction; nine grandchildren; and seven great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by a daughter, Becky Robinson, in 1973.

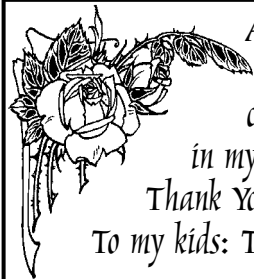
Wildflower hike set for Saturday

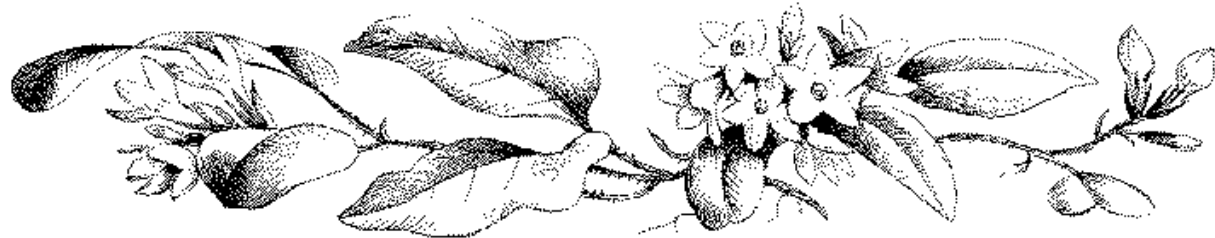
