COUGARS CLAW KNIGHTS - Illinois Valley High School's softball team wiped out North Valley in a doubleheader 11-1, 6-1 in Cave Junction on Saturday, May 3. I.V. scored five times in the first inning of the first game and knocked in six more for the win. Pitcher Kim Hamilton earned the win, fanning eight batters. She also was good for three singles and an RBI. In the nightcap Ashley D'Arpino notched two RBIs and brought in the Cougars' first run on a passed ball in the second. I.V. scored five more runs in the fifth. Also for I.V., Erika Riley had a RBI/single, and Kelsi Snook was 2-for-3 with a RBI. With its victory the Cougars retained their third-place position in the Skyline Conference with a 9-3 mark.



IVHS TOOK TOP HONORS at its home track meet on Thursday, May 1 with 169 team points. Leading the Cougar boys were Andi Eichmann and Rory Kaberline, each with two wins. Kaberline won the 300 hurdles in 44.7 and the 400 in 55.38. Eichmann took the long jump title with 18-9 feet, and ran the 200 in 24.30. I.V.'s Jon Riley heaved the javelin 156-10 for victory. The Cougs won the 400 relay (45.70) and 1,600 relay (3:52.16). Sam Green won the 110 hurdles (16.87) and Mike Pagnotta won the triple jump (39-11). I.V.'s Kim Hamilton won for her 135-2 javelin toss, and was victorious in the long jump (15-0) and 200 (28.73). Kirsten Wood won triple jump (30-3), 300 hurdles (52.40) and 100 hurdles (17.27).



I.V.'s Kit Armenta won the shot put (32-4) and discus (94-4); Emily Dudley took the 400 (1:10.24). The Cougs won the 400 relay in 55.53.
