Evergreen GP branch held up by a tall man

A suspect described by Grants Pass Dept. of Public Safety (GPDPS) as a white male adult in his mid-40s with crooked teeth, dark hair and wearing aviator-style sunglasses and a tan baseball cap fled the GP Evergreen Federal Bank branch on Tuesday, May 6 with an undisclosed amount of money.

The robbery occurred at around 2 p.m. when the suspect approached a bank teller and demanded money, according to a GPDPS news release.

The suspect indicated he had a gun, although no gun was seen, the release said.

After being given an uncertain amount of cash, the suspect quickly walked out of the west side of the bank, located at 969 S.E. Sixth St., and was last seen headed south toward the GP Caveman Bridge, GPDPS said.

Other suspect traits noted by GPDPS: Crooked teeth with some decay, weight between 185-190 pounds, 6-1 to 6-2 in height, and wearing a tan or dark brown lined coat and possibly denim jeans.

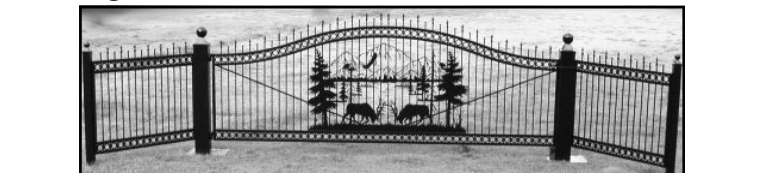

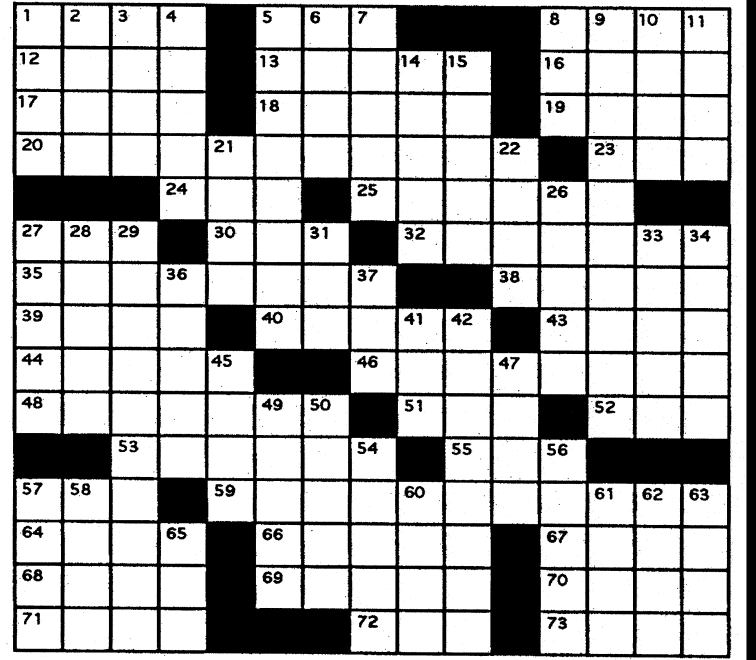

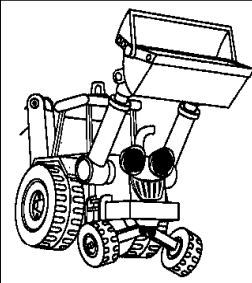
