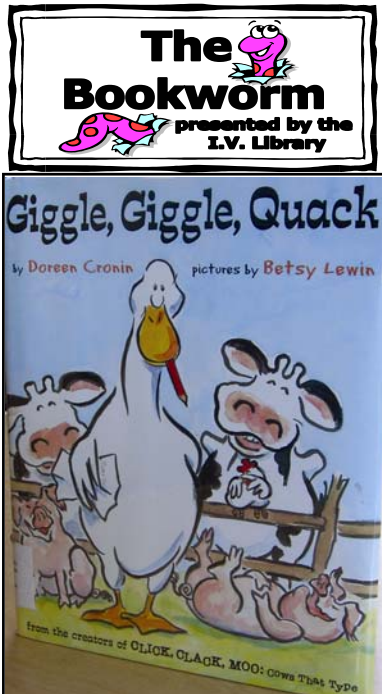
RCC offering Microsoft Word classes at IVHS
