sion, pool supporters joined council members, Haugen, Riddle and others for cake after the meeting.

The council also approved, a three-lot land partition of 2.6 acres at 330 N. Sawyer Road for builder Aubrey Roche and owner Kaaren Farmer.

As the only speaker in favor of the partition, Roche told the council that his intentions were to raise property values and maintain the neighborhood's integrity.

"We want to build nice homes in the area," he said. "We don't want to build boxes."

He said that the property needs to be brought up to code and would be willing to make any adjustments required by the city. No one spoke in opposition to the plan.

The council approved the partition 5-0 with the conditions that a survey and recording of final plat for all three parcels be accomplished; that drainage of the parcels is addressed and approved to city standards; that all taxes, fees and assessments be paid; and that zoning clearance is required for development of each parcel.

In other business, the council read for a second time, and then adopted, Ordinance 435, which raises business license fees from \$40 to \$50; and adopted the approved fiscal year 2003-04 budget in the sum of \$2,474,456.

Question: promised my husband that I would always take care of him at home but I am 78 and worry about what I will do if he falls and I can't get him up. Answer: Since this question has two parts, we will respond to one this month and the other next month.

It is important when someone falls in the home that you do not injure yourself trying to get them up. You may phone the fire department and explain you need their help with someone who has fallen. If you have a strong, helpful neighbor, they may be called. Prevention of falls is the best approach. Remove all throw rugs and clutter from walking areas in your home. Make sure that your hallways are well lit. Have grab bars installed in the bathrooms. A portable phone is also a good idea in case you are outdoors when the fall occurs, they can then phone for themselves.
