need. "We're severely lacking volunteers in I.V.," Stover said.

In the aftermath of a single-family or larger catastrophe like the Daisy Hill Fire, Disaster Action Team members directly assist victims and take care of such immediate needs as food, shelter and clothing. Members also provide referrals for other community organizations that can help with longer-term recovery.

Having a Disaster Action Team in the valley would mean a quicker response time to area disasters, Stover said.

For example, she noted, during the Daisy Hill Fire, had there been a team in the valley, fire officials could have contacted those members first instead of having to phone the Grants Pass office.

"It's less confusing that way," Carter said, noting that on the day of the fire someone from the GP office phoned her at around 7:30 p.m.

Besides, who better to respond to an area emergency than nearby residents, Stover added.

"We can only know it (the valley) so well when we're 45 minutes away," she said.

Each disaster team, comprised of two or three volunteers, is on call one week at a time. Therefore, the more teams available, the fewer on-call hours per group.

To become a Disaster Action Team member, a volunteer needs the following training classes: Introduction to disaster, family services, Disaster Action Team orientation and standard first aid. Damage assessment and shelter operations classes are also recommended. If at least four or five people noted interest in becoming team members, Stover said one of the training classes could be held in the valley.
