His statement, "I don't think we're getting the service we deserve and pay for" is inaccurate. The city pays for one full-time (40 hour a week) deputy plus the costs associated with that officer, such as a vehicle and equipment. It's obvious that the deputy cannot be everywhere and subject to the mayor's "beck and call" when you realize there are 168 hours in a week.

Several months ago I assigned one of my second-in-command officers, Lt. Lee Harman, to oversee the day-to-day operations of the Illinois Valley Substation.

It doesn't cost the city of Cave Junction a dime for the 40 hours a week Harman works in Downtown Cave Junction, which the 1,640 sq. miles of Josephine County. These deputies are answering calls for service from Wolf Creek to the California border and serving all of the citizens of Josephine County.

When a city chooses to incorporate, I believe the governing body and mayor assume a responsibility for providing basic services to that city.

The city of Cave Junction contracts for 40 hours a week which, while a move in the right direction. is far short of what is needed. Our responsibilities are to provide the best available service to all of the residents of the county, which we will continue to do.

For the mayor to suggest doing away with the only law enforcement in the city, and replace it with private security, is irresponsible.
