women were told to keep thinking of other possible ideas and to research what other businesses were already providing such services in the valley.

Williams also touched on the benefits of having a self-sufficiency program in this area.

"I'm finding it (domestic abuse) not only affects the women, but the children," she said, noting it is important to give children a strong structure.

Becoming financially stable is an element of that goal, Williams said.

"I have a special place in my heart for IVSHA," she said.

Williams said she plans to attend the next workshop at the resource center on E. River Street Oct. 2 from 4 to 6 p.m. For more information phone IVSHA at 592-4149.

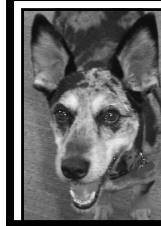
St. Patrick of the Forest Catholic Church

Many of us have spoken these words ourselves, but perhaps only in a casual manner. However, they carry a message that should be taken very seriously.

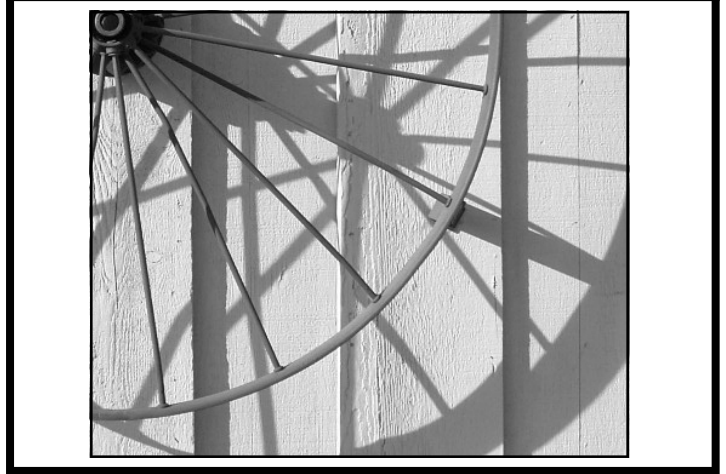
