October 6, 1781, the siege of Cornwallis began ... October 8-11, 1871, a huge fire destroyed the city of Chicago ... October 6, 1927,

October 7, 1985, four Palestinian hijackers seized the Italian cruise ship, the Achille Lauro, in the Mediterranean and held

it hostage for two days; one American, Leon Klinghoffer, was killed ... October 8, 1998, the House of Representatives voted 258-176 to proceed with the Clinton impeachment process ... October 12, 2000, 17 U.S. sailors were killed in the terrorist bombing of the U.S.S. Cole, refueling in Aden, Yemen ... October 7, 2001, the U.S. and Great

Britain launched a sustained air strike campaign against the Afghan-based terrorist organization al-Qaeda and the country's ruling Taliban militia ... October 8, 2002, President George W. Bush invoked the Taft-Hartley Act to get West Coast longshoremen back to work.
