made the score 19-14. The battle continued, with Pagnotta hitting Moore with a pass for a 58-yard score in the fourth. The 2-point conversion failed, but the Cougs took a 20-19 lead, and held it.

Pagnotta was good for 133 rushing yards, passing the 1,000 mark.

The victory took the Cougars to 3-1 in the Skyline Conference (6-1 overall), and a tie for first place with Mazama.

Reactivation of Oregon's No Call List Program is on hold until the 10th Circuit Court of Appeals decides whether to lift an injunction, Oregon Attorney General hardy Myers announced.

The injunction is by the Federal Trade Commission (FTC).

"If the court rules against FTC," said Hardy,

"we are ready to reactivate the Oregon No Call Program immediately to protect the privacy of 184,000 Oregonians now subscribing to Oregon's program.

"If the ruling is in FTC's favor and lifts the injunction, allowing the federal No Call Program to proceed, our program would be pre-empted and cannot continue."

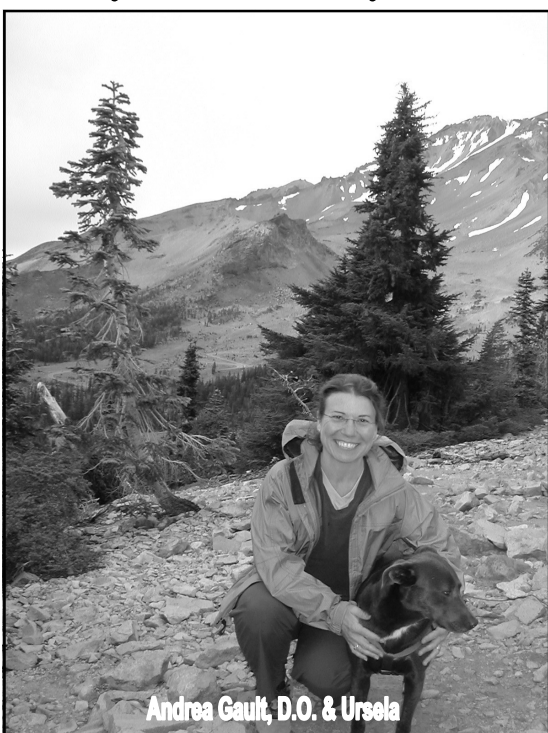
