The Board of Directors of the Arts Council of Southern Oregon announced that it has selected: Rebecca Pearson of Cave Junction, KOBI-TV, Art in Bloom, and the Southern Oregon Historical Society as recipients of the Arts and Culture Awards for 2003.

Pearson, known as the "Art Mom" of Cave Junction has been named Arts and Culture Volunteer for 2003. In the more than three years she has owned and operated BEBE's Art for Everyone, she has demonstrated the power of grass-roots community organizing in support of the arts and culture, according to a spokesman from the board.

She is president-elect

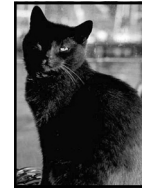
