

# Tales from the Police Blotter

**POLICE BLOTTER**

### Thursday, Dec. 4

\*A man in the 800 block of Crooks Creek Road said he gave a care provider a small change purse to use while running errands. The purse, which contained a social security card, driver's license, Oregon Trail Card, library card, \$200 cash and a post office key, was never returned. The care provider said she lost it.

\*Two juvenile boys were contacted by deputies for possession of large marijuana stems at Evergreen Elementary School. A report was filed for possession of a controlled substance within 1,000 yards of a school.

\*Justin Horn, 14, was cited and released to the custody of his father for shoplifting at Shop Smart Food Warehouse in Downtown Cave Junction.

on a charge of a restraining order violation. He was transported to Josephine County Adult Jail in Grants Pass.

\*At 4:25 p.m., a man contacted deputies to inform her he had recovered his stolen vehicle from a location on Wood

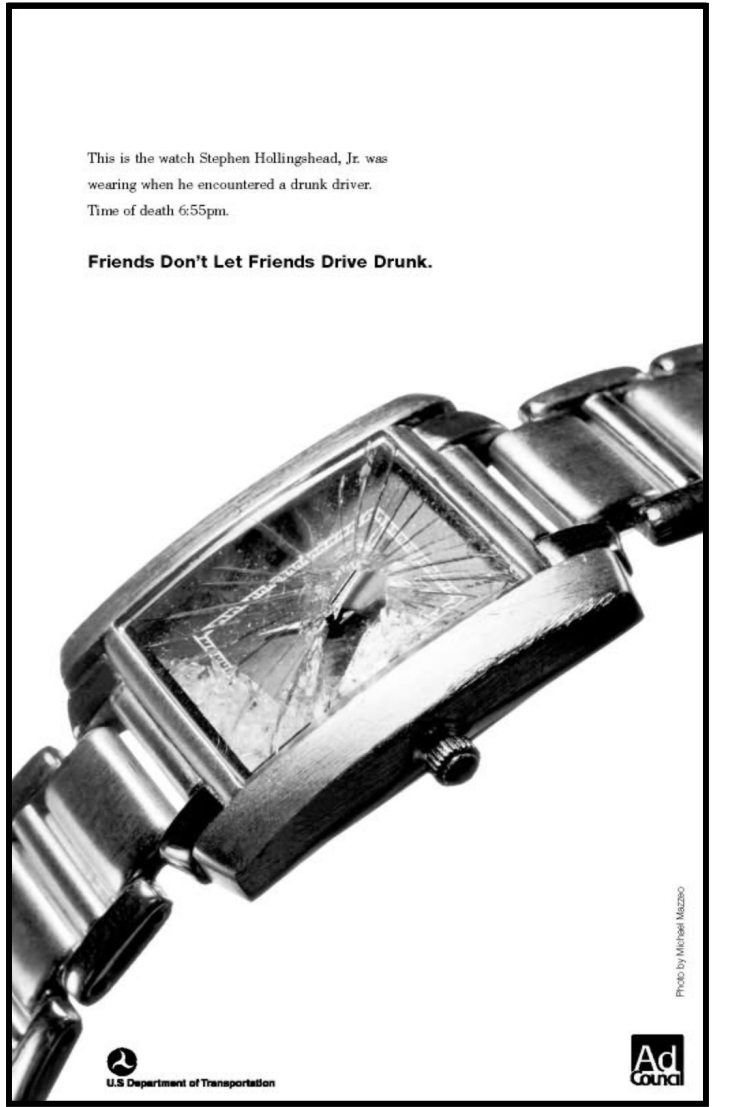
Creek Road.

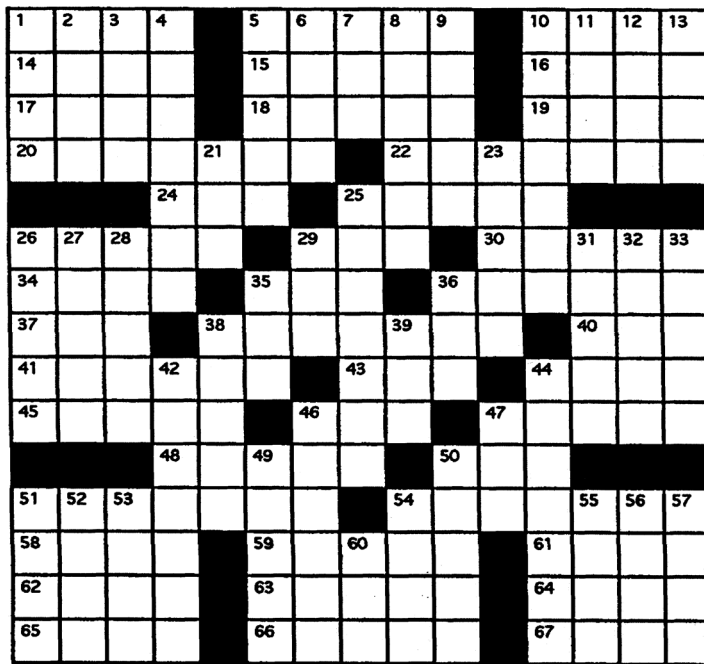
