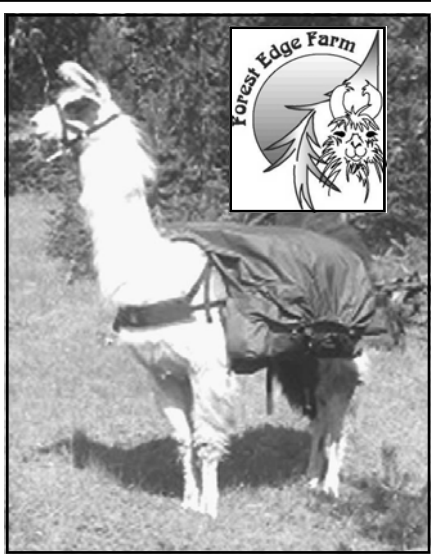

# Jan. 21 set for open hearing on Medford air quality

Due to a continuing local interest in the Oregon Dept. of Environmental Quality's (DEQ) proposed Medford-Ashland PM-10 (Particulate) attainment and Maintenance Plan, DEQ is extending the public comment period for the plan to Friday, Jan. 30.

DEQ will hold an additional public hearing Wednesday, Jan. 21, in Medford, to take oral and written comments on the plan. Written comments may also be submitted by mail at the address below.

The proposed plan is designed to assure that the area will continue to meet federal and state air quality standards for PM-10 particulate matter through at least 2015. It is based on computer modeling of pollution trends and population growth. The proposed plan is available on DEQ's Web site at [www.deq.state.or.us/aq/index.htm](http://www.deq.state.or.us/aq/index.htm).

The formal hearing will begin at 5:30 p.m. Wednesday, Jan. 21 at the South Medford High School Auditorium. DEQ staff will be available beginning at 5 p.m.
