Mr. Tibbs was born Oct. 22, 1929 in Lookeba, Okla. He was a U.S. Army veteran and was awarded the Purple Heart for injuries sustained while serving in the Korean War.

He moved to Illinois Valley in 1947, coming from California. After working for the National Park Service at Oregon Caves National Monument for a time, he became a building contractor and built many homes in the Cave Junction area before retiring in 1980. He was a member of Selma Baptist Church.

Former Illinois Valley resident Sarah A. Powell, 41, died in Spokane, Wash. on Feb. 3, 2004.

She was born in Spokane on Jan. 21, 1963 and graduated from Lewis and Clark High School with honors. She attended Pomona College, the University of Washington and the Sorbonne.

Ms. Powell became interested in wine while at the Lycee Agricole de Macon-Davaye in France. She returned to the United States to study at University of California, Davis, where she received a degree in fermentation science in 1988.

She worked in the wine industry in South Africa, Australia, and New Zealand, and as assistant winemaker for The Hogue Cellars in Prosser, Wash.

In 1991 she became the winemaker for Foris Vineyards Winery in Cave Junction, where she remained for 10 years, winning many honors and awards. She created Vigneron Consulting to promote the best viticulture practices with grape growers.

In 2002, Ms. Powell became co-owner and winemaker for a new business, Roxy Ann Winery,
