Other than Illinois Valley, DHS lists sites in Merlin (two), Wonder, Sunny Valley, Wolf Creek (five), Grants Pass (17), and Hugo. There is also a site in Rogue River.

DHS lists 38 sites in Lane County; 30 in Clackamas. Jackson and Douglas counties each have 16 sites; Curry County two.

Under the notification program, letters will be sent to all residents who live within 300 feet of a drug lab in urban settings, and to residents within a fourth of a mile in rural settings. Letters will include the address of the drug lab and an informational brochure.
