

# Sale of children's names for commercial use opposed by Sen. Wyden bill

The names, ages and home addresses of millions of American children - some as young as 2 years old - are being bought and sold every day, often online, for the purpose of commercial marketing.

In early March, U.S. Sens. Ron Wyden (D-Ore.) along with Ted Stevens (R-Alaska) introduced the bipartisan Children's Listbroker Privacy Act to make that practice unlawful.

"The wholesale trafficking in specific information about individual children is something that I think most Oregon parents would find troubling - I certainly do," said Wyden.

Several federal statutes - such as the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA), the Family and Educational Rights and Privacy Act, and section 1061 of the No Child

Left Behind Act - regulate the collection and disclosure of information about children or students in narrowly specified circumstances.

However, once information about children has been collected and compiled - whether that's done in compliance with these statutes, or by any number of means that fall outside their scope - there is little to restrict its dissemination and use by others.

The Wyden legislation would prohibit anyone

from selling, buying, licensing, renting or leasing personal information about a person known to be under 16 unless the parent of the child has given express consent or unless the buyer certifies that the information is being obtained for a strictly non-marketing purpose.

The transfer of information for purposes that do not involve commercial marketing - such as distributing information about scholarship opportunities or tracking the spread of a disease - would not be affected by the bill.

In a case where a sale is permitted because the buyer's purpose is non-commercial, the bill would prohibit the buyer from later using the information for commercial marketing, or from providing the in-

formation to somebody else to use for commercial marketing.

The bill's enforcement provisions, like those in COPPA, give the Federal Trade Commission and state attorneys general the

power to go after violators. The Children's Listbroker Privacy Act is expected to be referred to the Senate Committee on Commerce, Science and Transportation, of which Wyden and Stevens are members.
