The celebration will run from Monday, May 3 through Friday, May 7.


The valley branch, as well as other of Sterling's newest Oregon branches, will serve refreshments and treats.

"This merger is consistent with our previously stated plans, putting us on track to become the leading community bank in the region," he said.






