'Phone before you dig or ...'

Those planning on landscaping, planting trees or building a fence this spring can avoid potential problems by following a "Phone before you dig" suggestion.

Many areas have underground utility lines. Inadvertently cutting through them can cause problems.

Phone the Oregon Utility Notification Center at (800) 332-2344 at least 24 hours in advance to mark underground utility lines.

The free service helps keep people safe when digging and helps prevent costly repairs to damaged lines, said Pacific Power.
