

Delivery in GP results in problem

A trucker from Washington state was cited on a charge of careless driving after his semitruck and trailer rig took out a utility pole, causing electrical power to be interrupted for several hours to a section of the city of Grants Pass.

Grants Pass Dept. of Public Safety (GPDPS) also said that the driver was Barry N. Bender, 24, of Bremerton. He is a driver for Transco Inc./McLane Distribution Service.

The accident was reported at 12:41 a.m. on Thursday, May 13 at Sixth and M streets. Bender tried to turn right onto M from Sixth to make a delivery at a 7-11 store. But he "cut the corner too close and hit the pole, severing it at ground level," said GPDPS. "Bender continued to pull forward, running over a (dry) fire hydrant and busting the top. The pole came to rest against one side of the trailer, with power lines coming in contact with a street light."

Pacific Power and Oregon Dept. of Transportation were called to the scene by GPDPS. The situation was cleared around 6 a.m.

During the time that power was off, residents at a nearby nursing facility were assisted by officers and American Medical Response medics, who provided oxygen bottles.

It was Bender's first delivery to that 7-11, noted GPDPS.
