GP homicide investigated as suspect

Sheriff's detectives are seeking information about the apparent homicide of a rural Grants Pass resident whose home seems to have been forcibly entered.

Dead is Charles Kugle Jr., 68, of Shadow Hills Drive, said Detective Sgt. Ken Selig of Josephine County Sheriff's Office (JCSO).

JCSO was notified of an apparent break-in at Kugle's residence on Wednesday morning, May 12. He was found to be deceased, and, "It appears his home was forcibly entered." He lived alone, said Selig.

"It is apparent that he did not die of his own hand or natural causes," he added. An autopsy is pend-

State land hearing May 24

The Dept. of State Lands (DSL) will conduct a public meeting Monday, May 24 at 7 p.m. in Harbor to outline proposed changes to rules on restrictions on use of state lands.

The meeting will run two hours at the Harbor Sanitary District Conference Room, 16408 Lower Harbor Road.

According to Assistant Director John Lilly, the State Land Board in the past has restricted public use of several limited areas of state-owned lands. Examples include 10 stateowned estuaries. Restricted activities have included overnight camping, open fires during periods of wildfire danger and the use of motor vehicles.

The restrictions have been in place as a result of DSL director orders. The areas were closed to address problems reported by users, land owners, DSL staff, or representatives of other agencies or law enforcement officials.
