Former Illinois Valley resident Helen Marie (Grant) Appy, 88, died of natural causes Monday, May 31, 2004 in San Pedro, Calif.

Mrs. Appy was born in Oklahoma, and moved to Brawley, Calif. at a young age. She was raised in the Glendora area. She graduated with a bachelor of arts degree in English from UCLA in 1937, a master’s degree in drama from USC in 1938, and along the way studied voice under Madame Ellen Beach Yaw.

She married Henri Jean Appy in 1940. In 1946, in true pioneering spirit, Helen, Henri and their three children moved to Illinois Valley, where they purchased a 169-acre ranch near Cave Junction. Here she made soap, canned fruit, slopped hogs, raised turkeys, taught at Kerby Union and Illinois Valley High schools and had a fourth baby along the way.

In 1958, the couple sold their property and returned to Southern California, and bought a home in Fullerton.

Through the years, Mrs. Appy taught English, drama, and creative writing at Anaheim High School, Fullerton Union High School, Garden Grove High School and Illinois Valley High School. Said her family, “She passes on to all who knew her a legacy of optimism, stoic determination and work ethic, dedication to family, friends and students, and clear distinctions in life between right and wrong.”

Mrs. Appy was preceded in death by her husband, who died in 1996 at 84. She is survived by her four children: Carol Jean Kunold of Bainbridge Island, Wash; Marie McClanahan of Carillo, Calif.; Henri Jean Appy Jr. of McKinleyville, Calif.; Ralph Grant Appy of Rancho Palos Verdes, Calif.; 11 grandchildren; and 16 great-grandchildren.

Democrats boycott House session

House Speaker Karen Minnis (R-Wood Village) on Tuesday, June 1 followed through on her duty to convene the House of Representatives under House Joint Resolution 42, passed in August requiring the Legislature to meet in special session last week.

Minnis called the House to order at 9:05 a.m. and adjourned it at 9:23 a.m. after the House failed to reach the required quorum of 40 members to conduct business “because the Democrats boycotted the session.”

“I can respect a worthy adversary if they choose to disagree with my position and vote against me,” said Minnis. “I cannot however,

respect those who use their absence from the body to which they have been elected as a strategy to obstruct a vote which could result in the passage of something with which they disagree.

“It is a cynical rationalization, a dereliction of duty and an insult to the voters of this great state.”

Because the Senate Democrats also failed to show up as required — denying the Senate a quo-

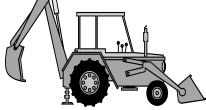
rum as well — neither chamber was able to organize to conduct business and therefore, there was no special session. As such, the payment of per diem or mileage expenses to members of the Legislature is not authorized, and no costs were incurred.

Minnis said afterward that, if elected speaker in 2005, she would continue to make enactment of a spending limit and rainy day fund a priority.
