After a long bout with cancer, former Selma resident Bill Lowe died July 6, 2004 in the arms of his wife, Darlene, in Paradise, Calif.

After graduation, Lowe worked for Pacific Bell for several years before joining the city of Los Angeles Fire Dept. in 1968. He retired 30 years later. In January 1968, Mr. Lowe married his wife, Darlene, in Las Vegas, Nev. and lived in Southern California during his time in the fire service.

He and his wife left California to retire in Selma, Ore. in 1992. Living there for eight years, said his wife, they found many loving and close friendships that were and are enjoyed and treasured by them.

Mr. Lowe was a member of the Grants Pass Elks Lodge and, for a short time, a member of the Deer Creek Cemetery Board. He and his wife were proud to be members of the Selma community, said Mrs. Lowe.

Mr. Lowe is survived by his wife, Darlene, of Paradise, Calif.; three sons, Tony Lowe, of New York, N.Y., Barry Lowe, of Mission Viejo, Calif., and Troy Lowe, of San Jose, Calif.; and nine grandchildren.
