

Rogue River navigability study OK'd by land board

Citing that a broad and substantial public interest exists in determining the navigability of a 90-mile stretch of the Rogue River, the State Land Board has authorized the start of a navigability study.

Before its 3-0 vote, the three board members on Tuesday, Oct. 12 in Salem voiced support for a legislative alternative to navigability studies to resolve issues related to public access to rivers in Oregon.

“However, until such a solution is in place, we

have no recourse except to follow existing law,” said Secretary of State Bill Bradbury.

“Authorizing this study does not stop attempts to find other solutions,” he added.

“If ever there was a time to resolve this, it is now,” said Gov. Kulon-goski.

“That means bringing people together to discuss the legal issues and the property owner issues at stake so we can develop a workable solution that

meets the needs of land owners and upholds the laws of our state,” said the governor.

In remarks after the meeting, State Treasurer Randall Edwards noted that the study is necessary because there is legal ambiguity about the rights of private property owners and the public to the bed and banks of the river.

Edwards was chairman of a working group seeking a solution during the 2003 legislative session.

A former Josephine

County district attorney filed the original Rogue River navigability study request in 1997 for the upper river from Grave Creek to Lost Creek.

The current D.A. recently confirmed interest in pursuing the study, as have some law enforcement officials.

Dept. of State Lands staff will begin work this winter. It is anticipated that the process will take from 12 to 18 months before a final determination by the land board.

Livestock study for monument continuing Oct. 29

The Provincial Advisory Committee (PAC) working group in charge of reviewing the Bureau of Land Management’s livestock study for the Cascade-Siskiyou National Monument (CSNM) will meet Friday, Oct. 29.

BLM has asked the group for help in increasing public understanding of the livestock study, reviewing the current study, and providing it with recommendations regarding the study.

study the impacts of livestock grazing on the objects of biological interest in the monument, with specific attention to sustaining the natural ecosystem dynamics.”

In order to carry out the intent of the proclamation, BLM has implemented a study of livestock effects. The study is a conglomerate of monitoring projects designed to establish a baseline of site-

specific information on important biological objects, resources, and processes.

The data also will be used to conduct an overall assessment of the monument grazing allotments and to evaluate whether or not the allotments are meeting the Oregon Standards for Rangeland Health.

If the present grazing practices are found incom-

patible with protecting the objects of biological interest, BLM would consider modifying the leases to achieve compatibility or retire the grazing allotments.

Withing the CSNM, 11 ranchers hold grazing leases for 2,714 AUMs (animal unit months). An AUM is the amount of forage needed to support one cow or a one cow/calf pair for one month.

The meeting will be held at the Oregon State University Extension office at 569 Hanley Road in Central Point.

The goal of the meeting is to continue discussing the public participation process and increase the working group’s understanding of the current livestock study.

Membership of the working group represents a diversity of interests including recreation/tourism, environmental, conservation, Jackson County Natural Resources Advisory Committee, National Park Service, and the Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board.

PACs were established in the early 1990s to help involve the public in the management of federal forests.
