Kent H. Johnson

A potluck memorial gathering for Selma resident and longtime Illinois Valley volunteer firefighter Kent Howard Johnson, 55, who died Jan. 22, 2005, will be held Saturday, Feb. 5 at 2 p.m. at the Selma Center.

Mr. Johnson died at Providence Medical Center in Medford. He suffered from lung disease. Cremation is planned.

Mr. Johnson was born on Jan. 6, 1950 in Glendale, Calif. He lived in Utah before coming to Oregon in 1980.

He served 14 years as a volunteer firefighter with Illinois Valley Fire District, achieving the rank of battalion chief at Station 2 in Selma. Several years ago he was inducted into the “Hall of Flame” by the Illinois Valley Volunteer Firefighters Association.

Mr. Johnson was a mail carrier from 1983 to 1998 for Selma, Kerby and Wilderville.

Much of his spare time was spent fishing at Lake Selmac, and picking mushrooms. He volunteered for several years assisting the girls softball team at Illinois Valley High School.

Survivors are his wife, Lynn Johnson, of Selma,

who he married on March 14, 1970 in Arleta, Calif.; two daughters, Jennifer Moe, of Madras, Ore., and Justine Johnson, of Selma; his parents, Phil and Ruth Johnson, of Dallas, Ore.; a brother, Marc Johnson, of Ronan, Mont.; a sister, Deanna Johnson, of Tigard, Ore., and two grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by a brother, Scott Johnson, who died in 2001 of the same lung disease that Mr. Johnson had.

The family said that it appreciates the community for their love, prayers and support.

George P. Hagan

A memorial service for George Patrick Hagan, 44, who died Dec. 15, 2004 at Three Rivers Community Hospital in Grants Pass, was held Thursday, Jan. 27.

The memorial, which included a potluck gathering, was held at Blue Moon Café in Cave Junction.

Mr. Hagan was born on Nov. 29, 1960 in Fayetteville, Ark. He worked in the dry cleaning industry, where he developed an expert knowledge of fabrics. He was a tailor, who also designed and made costumes.

Mr. Hagan moved to Oregon from Fayetteville in the late 1980s, and relocated to Cave Junction in 2003 from Corvallis. In Cave Junction he owned, “Simply Threadful,” a sewing and mercantile shop.

He was known for his love of singing, as he had an Irish tenor falsetto voice. He also enjoyed Celtic music, and wrote poetry, some of which has been published.

Surviving are a sister, Nina Colson, of Burbank, Calif.; and four brothers, Michael Hagan, of West Fork, Ark., Richard Hagan and James Hagen, both of Fayetteville; and Russell Hagan, of Florida.

Paul M. Pfohl

Kerby resident Paul Matthew Pfohl, 87, died Sunday, Jan. 30, 2005 at Three Rivers Community Hospital in Grants Pass.

Visitation will be from 4 to 7 p.m. Wednesday, Feb. 2 at Hull & Hull Funeral Directors, Grants Pass. A Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated at 11 a.m. Thursday, Feb. 3 at St. Anne Catholic Church, also in Grants Pass.

Interment will follow at Hillcrest Memorial Park in Grants Pass.

Mr. Pfohl was born on July 6, 1917 in Cheektowaga, N.Y. He grew up on a 200-acre hog farm in Buffalo, N.Y. In the 1930s he raced Harley Davidson and Norton Manx motorcycles.

On July 27, 1942 in Hopewell, Va. he married the former Norma Catherine Phillip, who died in 1987. During World War II he taught motorcycle riding in the U.S. Army and attained the rank of master sergeant.

During the 1950s he raced sports cars. He owned and operated Lancaster Stone Products in Buffalo with his three brothers. In 1964 he moved from Buffalo to Kerby, where he enjoyed ranching.

He was a member of St. Patrick of the Forest Catholic Church in Cave Junction. He was a life member of Sports Car Club of America.

During his early years he enjoyed hunting, especially in Jackson Hole, Wyo. He also was a stock car racing fan.

Mr. Pfohl is survived by three daughters, Jacqueline

Doherty and Janine Pfohl, both of Kerby, and Mary Andrade, of Medford; his son, Bill Pfohl, of Kerby; two sisters, Margaret Bogner, of Hamburg, N.Y., and Marie Hauser, of Winterhaven, Fla.; a brother, Richard Pfohl, of Sarasota, Fla.; and six grandchildren.

Another son, Paul M. Pfohl Jr., died in 1972.

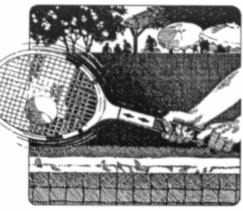

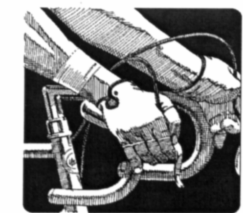
