

## Oregon Caves reopening

Tours of Oregon Caves National Monument will resume for the season Saturday, March 19, said Craig Ackerman, superintendent at the monument for the National Park Service.

The opening coincides with spring break for Oregon and California schools, said Ackerman. Cave tours last approximately 90 minutes and will operate on the following schedule.

\*March 19 through May 27: 10 a.m. to 4 p.m., tours on the hour.

\*May 28 through June 17: 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., tours on the hour.

\*June 18 through Sept. 5: 9 a.m. to 6:30 p.m., tours every 30 minutes.

Eighty percent of all money collected for tours stays at the monument for projects that improve facilities or directly benefit visi-

tors, Ackerman said.

A curriculum-based education program is provided at the monument so that school classes can be brought for free tours and other activities. Teachers can contact Joe Alexander at 592-2100, Ext. 226 for additional information.

Ackerman noted that there is a tour restriction for children too small to safely negotiate the cave stairs and passageways.

Youngsters must be at least 42 inches tall and be able to climb a set of test stairs to participate in a regular cave tour.

However, he noted, a special short, free tour is available for families with small children. Child-care services are not available.

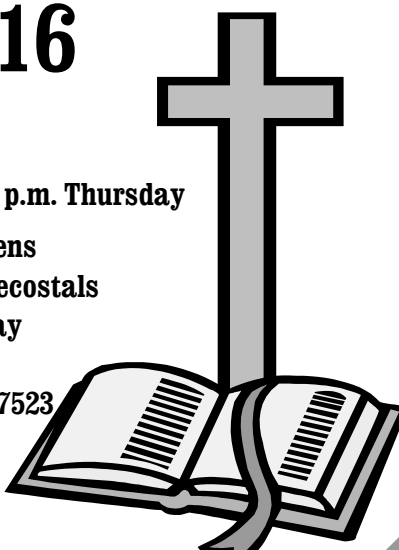

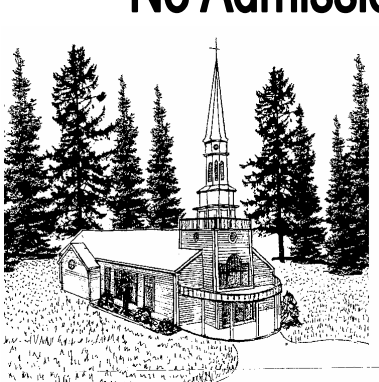
