Read appointed chief of DHS

Veteran state administrator Lynn Read, of Salem, has been appointed interim administrator of the Oregon Dept. of Human Services (DHS) Office of Medical Assistance Programs (OMAP), effective Friday, June 24.

The appointment was made by DHS Interim Director Bryan Johnston.

OMAP administers the Medicaid portion of the Oregon Health Plan, which serves more than 350,000 Oregonians. Read, OMAP senior dep-

uty administrator since November 2004, is the former state Medicaid director and OMAP assistant administrator.

Read, who joined DHS in 1979, has worked in Oregon’s Medicaid program in a variety of capacities including project director for the design, development and 1994 implementation of the Oregon Health Plan.

Read succeeds Barney Speight, who was named deputy administrator of the Washington State Health Care Authority in Olympia.

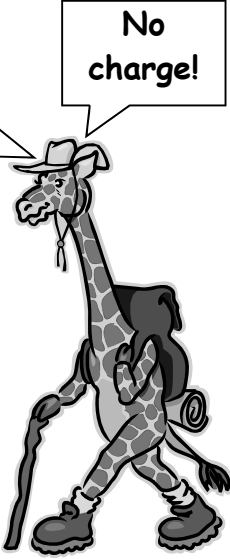
