

Tales from the Police Blotter

Monday, May 30
*Approximately \$5,000 worth of vandalism to logging equipment on Arrowhead Drive was reported. The complainant said that "fingerprints were all over the equipment."

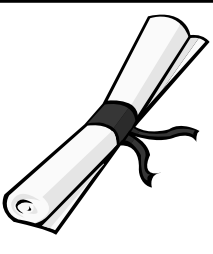
*A horse was running back and forth across Hwy. 199 at Sauer's Flat at 2:59 p.m.
