Mama, go to your room!

A recently completed mothering room is open at Rogue Community College in Grants Pass, with plans calling for similar areas soon on all RCC campuses.

The rooms will provide a private, safe, comfortable area set aside for nursing and expressing or pumping milk, said Andrea Siebert, accounting specialist.

The RWC site is a cozy space off the women's locker room in the gym.

"It had been a dream of Rachelle Lagorio's, so we are really excited the college is doing this," said Lisa Stanton, director of Budget and Financial Services.

A soon-to-be installed plaque reads:

"This mothering room is dedicated to the loving memory of Rachelle Lagorio." A senior account-

ant, she died May 19, 2004. Her husband, Grant, is assistant director of Facilities and Operations.

A changing table will be installed in the mothering room, and similar units will be placed in men's and women's restrooms located near high-traffic areas, such as Rogue Central, at all campuses.

The American Academy of Pediatrics recommends breastfeeding for at least the first 12 months after childbirth, Siebert said. Benefits include higher IQs and reduced chronic diseases.

"Mothering rooms make it easier for nursing mothers to attend school, plus there's less absenteeism of staff and students, and health-care costs are lower," Stanton added.

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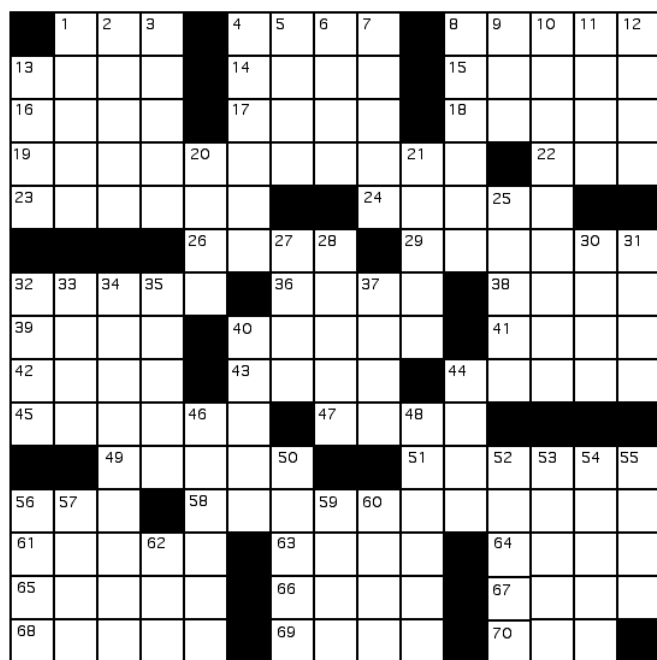
