## Injured Kerby woman dies in Portland

The victim of a vehicle vs. pedestrian accident, Kerby resident Vicki Lee LaVada, 58, died in a Portland hospital Sunday, Aug. 28, as her husband, Larry, decided to take her off life support, he said.

She was struck by a northbound pickup truck after she had gone to check the mail at 23823 Redwood Hwy. on the east side of the road Friday, Aug. 26 at approximately 5:25 p.m., said Oregon State Police.

The pickup, with door signs reading FD Thomas,

of Central Point, was driven by Gold Hill resident Carl G. Buell, 44, OSP said. Witnesses at Kerbyville Farm, across from the scene, said that she was knocked approximately 15 feet.

Buell was cited on a charge of violation of the basic rule (driving too fast for conditions), said OSP.

Buell told OSP that he didn't at first see LaVada, and that he braked and swerved to avoid a stopped car, struck some mailboxes and then the woman, who tried to run away. The

pickup knocked her face down onto a graveled drive.

Medical aid and other assistance at the scene were provided by American Medical Response, a passing ER physician, Illinois Valley Fire District, and Josephine County Sheriff's Office.

Mrs. LaVada was taken by a Mercy Flights helicopter from Sauer's Flat to Rogue Valley Medical Center in Medford; then transferred to Portland.

LaVada's first two wives died of cancer.

## 2 arrested after chase

Described as a "very dangerous wanted felon," Conan James Lapping, 24, was arrested in Crescent City, Calif. after a shooting incident near Rogue River.

Oregon State Police said that Lapping was arrested Saturday morning, Aug. 27 following a car chase with shots fired, and a standoff at a house the day before in the East Evans Creek Road area southeast of Grants Pass.

Numerous police agencies, including an OSP SWAT team, were involved.

Also sought in connection with the incident was John Tomsson Hench, 22, considered armed and dangerous, OSP said. It added that he surrendered voluntarily to Josephine County Sheriff's Office on the 27th.

In Crescent City, Lapping, surrounded by officers from the city police force, California Highway Patrol and Del Norte County Sheriff's Office, at first refused commands to comply.

He was wearing a ballistic vest and was armed with a 9mm handgun. He also had a wound from being shot Friday, Aug. 26 while trying to elude OSP officers and firing at them.

## Repair set for Agness Road

A construction project on Agness Road (U.S. Forest Service Road 33) began Monday, Aug. 29, with completion estimated close to Oct. 31.

Crews will construct a large retaining wall up the Rogue River from Gold Beach at milepost 31.6, said the U.S. Forest Service.

The project is to repair road damage caused by a slide during a 2002 storm.

A public road closure continues in effect on that segment of the road due to safety concerns, said the forest service. After the project is finished, the road segment will be reopened to public travel.
