Leslie William Saffer

A Funeral Mass was celebrated Friday, Nov. 11 at St. Anne Catholic Church in Grants Pass for Cave Junction resident Leslie William Saffer, 75, who died during his 46th annual elk hunt Nov. 5, 2005.

Interment followed at Hillcrest Memorial Park in Grants Pass. A reception was held in Cave Junction at St. Patrick of the Forest Catholic Church.

Mr. Saffer, who had the nicknames “Les” and “Dub,” was hunting on “his beloved” Grande Ronde River in Eastern Oregon, when he died.

He was born in Benton, Kan. Nov. 28, 1929, and his life was marked by love, joy and kindness, his family said.

He was known as a leader, with contagious charisma.

Mr. Saffer also was known for setting an example by retiring and living his dream of outdoor adventures while still committing time for family, friends, church and community.

He is survived by his wife of 52 years, Lorraine Saffer; two sons, Steve and Greg; a brother, Wayne; five sisters, Dolores, Marie, Evelyn, Azzlee and Pauline; seven grandchildren; and four great-grandchildren. He also leaves behind many other relatives and friends.

Mr. Saffer was preceded in death by a daughter, Lisa; his parents, Laura and Arville; a brother, Harold; and three sisters, Wanda, Ida and Ruth.
