

## DEQ monitors killing chems

Penalties of \$25,800 to the Washington Demilitarization Co. for a series of hazardous waste handling violations at the Umatilla Chemical Agent Disposal Facility in Hermiston have been issued by Oregon Dept. of Environmental Quality (DEQ).

Washington Demilitarization Co. and the U.S. Army operate the facility, which is responsible for incinerating chemical weapons stockpiled at the Army's nearby Umatilla Chemical Depot.

The facility, a large-quantity generator of hazardous waste, operates under a Hazardous Waste Storage and Treatment Facility permit issued by DEQ.

Violations were based on inspections DEQ conducted during March and April 2005, as well as the facility's own self reporting of permit and federal Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) violations during the first quarter of 2005.

In all, DEQ cited 19 violations of three hazardous waste management requirements.
