Former Takilma resident Brett Matussek, 57, died of a stroke at home in Eureka, Calif. Jan. 3, 2006.
He was born Sept. 9, 1948 in Madison, Wis. He graduated from Clayton High School in Concord, Calif., and joined the U.S. Navy in 1966. He was honorably discharged in 1967.
Mr. Matussek attended San Francisco State University, and was involved in a movement for ethnic literature classes and antiwar protests.

He moved to Takilma in the late 1960s to live in a commune; remaining in the community for several years, being involved in many alternative community endeavors. He relocated in 1999 to the Arcata/Eureka area in California.

Kyle William Vogel, a 19-year-old Grants Pass resident, who was valedictorian in June at Grants Pass High School, is the victim of an apparent suicide, said Grants Pass Dept. of Public Safety (GPDPS).
He was reported missing on Tuesday, Jan. 3 at 10 p.m. Family members and others searched, and his body was found early the next morning at St. Anne's Catholic Church, said GPDPS.

Free weatherization work possible, says Pac Power

Keeping homes free from excessive winter cold and summer heat is difficult for most home owners and renters; especially for many elderly or disabled residents.

"These services are available to qualifying low-income residents and are covered by federal funding and money Pacific Power collects through the public purpose charge included in customer bills," said Becky Eberle, Pacific Power's program manager.
"We encourage our senior and disabled customers who may qualify for free weatherization services to contact ACCESS Inc. and get on their waiting list right away. Weatherization will help improve your home's energy efficiency in the winter and summer months."
ACCESS Inc. receives numerous requests for low-income weatherization services, but gives priority to qualifying elderly and disabled Pacific Power customers who heat their homes using electricity. There is a waiting period before services will be available.
"Insulation doesn't

know whether it's hot or cold. It simply protects against the elements in any season," said Dan Cunningham, energy programs manager of ACCESS Inc. "The services we provide include attic, wall and floor insulation, window and door installations, and specific services for mobile homes.
"There are a variety of things we can do to make a home (single-family, mobile home or an apartment) more energy efficient and save people money on heating and cooling costs."
