Wages for the teenagers will come from grant funds as well as fees from those who hire them. There is a sliding fee schedule for senior citizens and persons with disabilities. The priority for work will be given to these two groups. Other I.V. residents also can request help from the teens.

The project goals are to train youth on a variety of jobs so that they will be attractive applicants to employers in the valley; build relationships between youth and senior citizens; and encourage positive work ethics now as well as in school or other situations.

Participants also will donate a portion of their available time to community service projects.

The teen-agers will be part of the decision-making for projects.
