Sandbergs' photography provides many fine views

From photography to knife-making to rocket science, Dale Sandberg is a man of many talents and interests.

And he and his wife, Elaine, share many of those interests, especially photography. That love of photography began early in life for Sandberg. He recalls how, when he was 17, President Eisenhower visited his hometown's airport. Sandberg was eager for a picture of the president, but it was never meant to be.

"I didn't have a stick of film on me," he said.

Their photos frequently appear in "Illinois Valley News," and he is the official photographer for Illinois Valley Fire District (IVFD). "We're a team," said Dale, who went through the IVFD Fire Academy.

He and Elaine frequently work together on assignments for the "News."

And when an IVFD alarm sounds, she often accompanies him.

Sandberg grew up in western Illinois, near the Iowa border. He attended elementary and middle school there, and graduated from United Township High School in 1957. He earned Eagle Scout rank in the Boy Scouts of America.

For his first job, he worked in the farm implement industry. Then in 1962, he joined the U.S. Air Force and was trained as a missile engine mechanic.

During his four-year stint in the military, Sandberg helped develop the Atlas missile. The

"She was giving me a bad time about washing my whites and colors together," Sandberg said. "It was just like in the movies."

The two married and began planning for the future. However, they decided that a change of location was badly needed, and Elaine started looking north toward Oregon.

"We wanted a place to raise our kids out of the city," Elaine said.

She had friends in Illinois Valley, so she scouted the area. The Sandbergs bought property from their friends and moved with their three sons to Cave Junction in 1979.

"We packed up our kids and left," Sandberg said. "It worked out well for us."

Sandberg spent 23 years working as a saw filer at Rough & Ready Lumber Co. before retiring two and a half years ago.

"When the mill shut down the first time (because of a lack of timber for harvesting), I retired,"
