Child-care tax credits info outlined

With tax season again upon us, the Oregon Child Care Resource & Referral Network has launched an outreach campaign to ensure that more eligible families know about valuable state and federal child-related income tax credits.

"You Earned It, So Claim It!" is the statewide campaign of the network's members, which are child-care resource and referral programs that help families find and choose child-care. The campaign is conducted in collaboration with the National Women's Law Center of Washington, D.C. and several states.

"In our work with families in every county, we see many families struggling with the costs of child-care and running a household," said Mary Nemmers, the network's chief.

"We want to make sure that every eligible family knows these tax credits are available to help make child-care more affordable," she said.

According to the most recent state of Oregon data, the average cost of child care for a toddler in a family child-care home runs \$480 a month and \$865 in a child-care center.

If you like to dance, if you like good music, in short if you like a good time you will not want to miss the Legion dance Saturday.

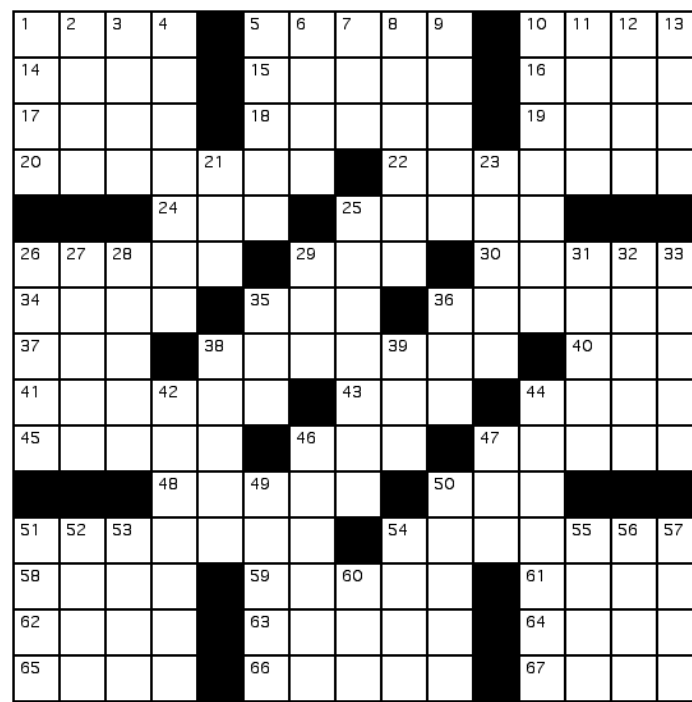
