Goines hopes for fruitful musical tour in Big Apple

Illinois Valley musical artist Libby Goines has an appetite to take a bite of the Big Apple.

Goines plans to travel to New York City this month for a series of gigs to promote her 1999 CD, "Hope Mountain." And she hopes to use her 10-day tour to land a distribution deal for that album and pave the way for a follow-up.

"I have so much material, I could release two record albums now," Goines said. "And I'm ready."

She attributes her love of music to her father. Her childhood was filled with the sounds of classical composers including Bach and Beethoven, with the influence continuing to this day.

"My dad loves all the classics," Goines said. "He liked to crank it up, too."

Goines first took up playing guitar at 8. One of her older siblings owned

one, but had long since left it collecting dust. She then set about learning the delicate art of songwriting, and eventually learned piano in her late teens.

From 1994 to 2003, Goines hit the open road, touring and gigging wherever she could. During that time, she played at the World Peace Festival and other large events.

"I hit every open mic I could find," she said.

Family obligations brought her back home for a while, but she still longed for the rock-'n'-roll lifestyle. She was prepared to leave

again in 2003 when her car broke. Fixing it would have been cost-prohibitive, so Goines opted to stay settled.

"I had a longing in my heart to share my music with the world, but I couldn't," she said. "I was tethered." Goines then helped establish the Upstairs Art Gallery in Cave Junction, along with local artists Gabriella Salas and Katrina Mendenfriend. She continued honing her musical skills, but was interrupted last year when her wrist broke in a fall.

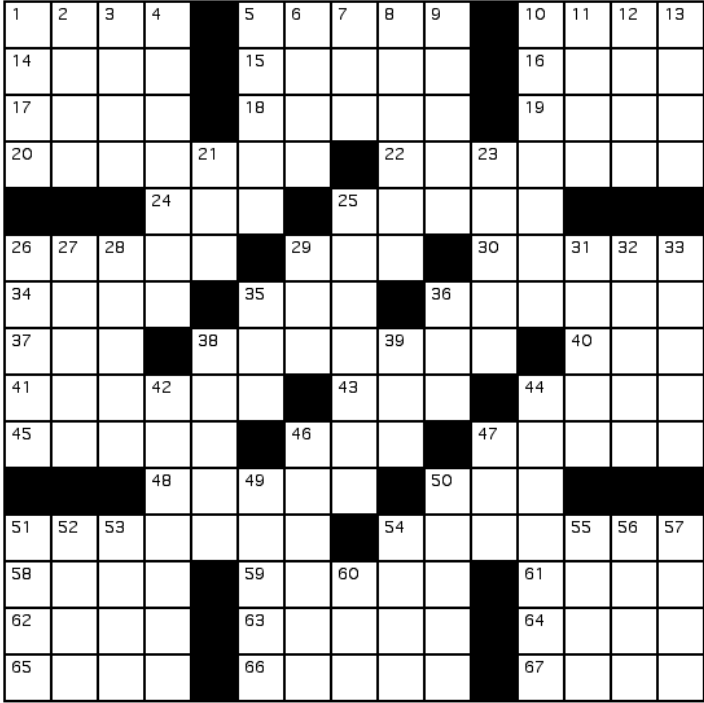
Tumbling through the Siskiyou mountains before reaching the Pacific Ocean, the
