

He was found hiding under wrecked cars. Officers used an X-26 Advanced Air Taser when the man refused to respond to commands. He subsequently was taken to county jail.

A: Many patients who have hospice services are still walking and eating, and some continue to drive! Illnesses and diseases have very different expected courses resulting in varying anticipated rates of decline. Most medical experts now agree that a patient and their loved ones have need for hospice services if the life expectancy might more easily be measured in months rather than years, if the illness takes its expected course.

Patients and families face many challenges in the last 6-12 (or more) months of life and often have increasing physical symptom needs. Hospice can be a greater benefit to the patient and family when service is started prior to having a physical crisis or becoming bedbound.
