Savannah was born on April 24, 1989 in Takilma to Chris & Deelia (Cooke) Bassett. She was raised in Cave Junction, and attended Evergreen Elementary and Lorna Byrne Middle schools. She graduated from Illinois Valley High School on June 5, 2007.

At IVHS she was a cheerleader all four years, and was on the competition team during her senior year. She was involved with the Swing Choir all four years, and was a Cougar Pal, serving as a mentor to elementary-age children. Until her senior year she was a member of Awana Clubs International.

She planned on attending Linfield College in McMinnville as an art history major. She especially enjoyed photography, art, traveling and reading.

Savannah is survived by her parents, Deelia & Scott Warner, of Cave Junction; three brothers, Joshua, of Bend, and Derek and Sam, of Cave Junction; a sister, Nisha, of Cave Junction; and her grandparents, Patsy Mae Bassett, of Salem, Frank Cooke, of Cave Junction, Patricia Hunt, of Coeur d'Alene, Idaho, Hank Warner, of Cave Junction, and Dixie & Norm Cegelnik, of Selma.

## Crystal Dick

A funeral service was held Saturday, June 9 for former Cave Junction resident and Illinois Valley school teacher Crystal Darlene Prine Dick, 71, who died Sunday, June 3, 2007 at her home in Evanston, Wyo.



Interment was conducted at Evanston Cemetery following The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints service in the Almy Ward chapel in Evanston.

Crystal was born in Soda Springs, Idaho on March 25, 1936 to William and Ethel Prine. Her family moved to Prineville, where she grew up in the town named after a great-uncle. She attended Crook County High School, and then Brigham Young University in Rexburg, Idaho; and earned her degree in secondary education. She taught at Douglas High School and then at Illinois Valley High School in Cave Junction, where she met her husband and eternal companion, Stanley "Stan" Dick.

They were married on June 18, 1960, and one year later had their marriage solemnized in the LDS Idaho Falls Temple. The couple remained

devoted to each other for 47 years of married life. After raising her children to adolescence, Crystal returned to work, teaching physical education and home economics for 16 years at Lorna Byrne Middle School in Cave Junction.

She felt fortunate to work with Stan, who taught P.E. and woodshop. They were active in the LDS Church, Cave Junction Ward.

Crystal retired in 1994; and she and Stan eventually moved to Prineville, then several places in Utah (American Fork and Vernal), and Rock Springs, Wyo. They settled in Evanston in 2001 to be near their children and grandchildren and to enjoy the country lifestyle where they felt at home.

She was known as a loving mother, wife, grandmother, aunt and friend. Crystal stayed active in her community and church all her life. Her family said that few people came in contact with her who didn't remember her smile and her genuine concern for them, as she loved everyone unconditionally and made friends easily wherever she went.

Her faith, her family and her friends assisted her through the rough times during her three-and-a-half year battle with cancer.

## Prescription plan approved

Gov. Kulongoski has signed Senate Bill 362 to expand the Oregon Prescription Drug Program to include the private sector, labor unions and all underinsured Oregonians who lack full prescription drug coverage.

"By pooling the buying power of individuals for prescriptions, we are working together to help thousands of Oregonians leverage better prices for their medicines and save hundreds of dollars a year," said Kulongoski.

"Private employers and unions can now take advantage of the value pricing that this program has negotiated on behalf of its members."


The Oregon Prescription Drug Program was established during 2003 to help low-income uninsured Oregonians older than 54 afford the high cost of prescription drugs. Through the power of bulk purchasing for prescriptions, and by pooling resources, the state is able to negotiate lower prices for prescriptions than what individuals and businesses normally could negotiate.

During November 2006 the program was expanded under Ballot Measure 44 to

allow all Oregonians without prescription drug coverage to access the program.

Since the passage of Ballot Measure 44, the number of Oregonians enrolled in the program has more than tripled to nearly 16,000 members. Oregonians enrolled in the program can save on average \$28 per prescription and savings can be as high as 60 percent of retail prices, the governor said.

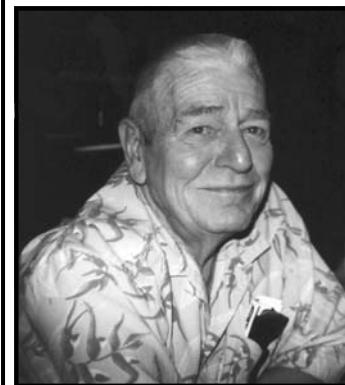

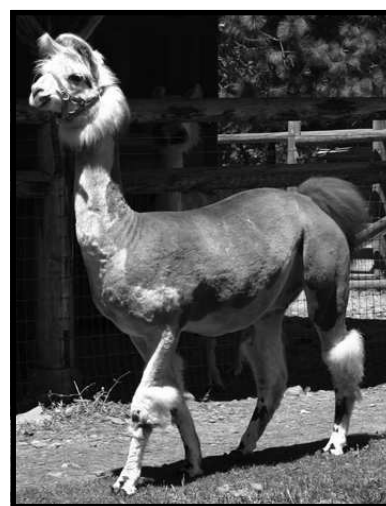
