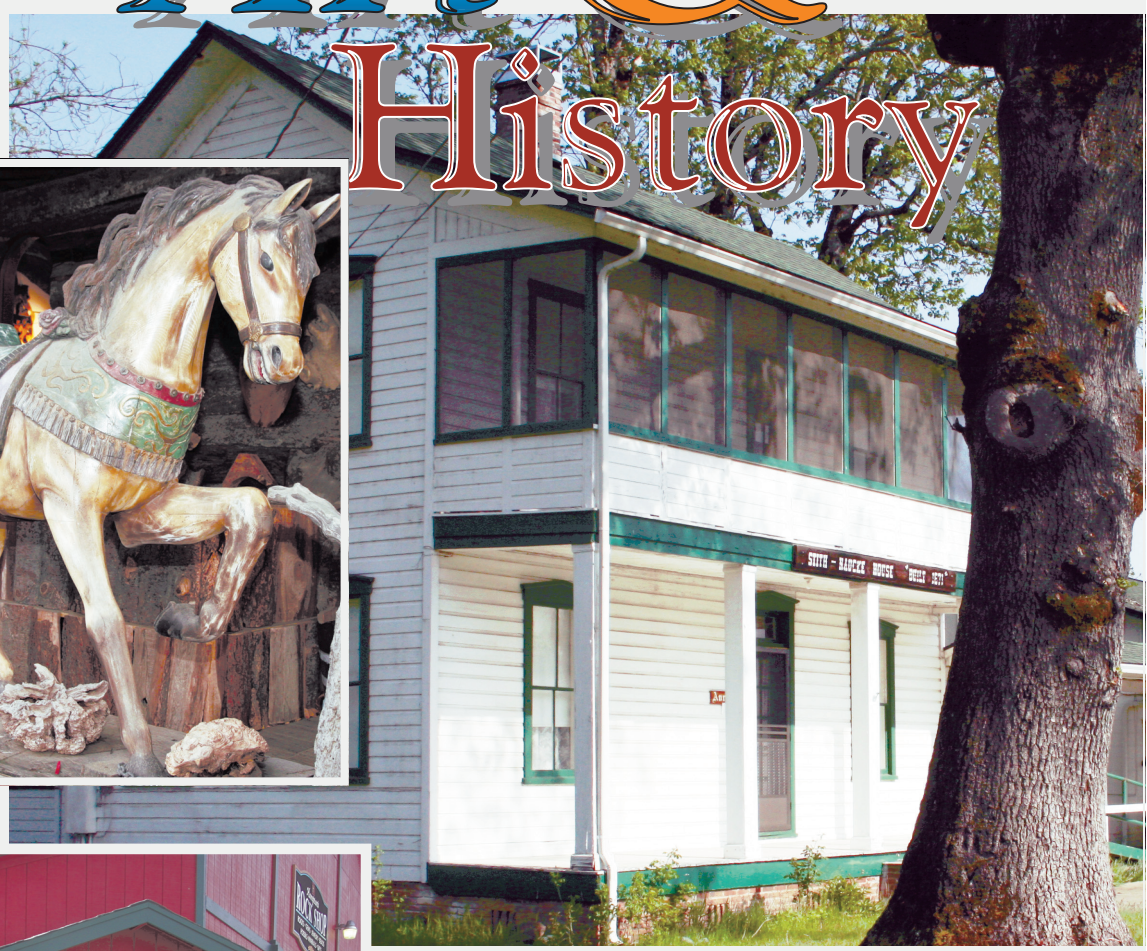


Art & History
