HORSING AROUND

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There are many scenic places to enjoy horse-back riding in the Illinois Valley area. Some are within an easy drive of Cave Junction, and include horse-camping facilities. Here are some of the best locations.

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Sam Brown Horse Camp is off U.S. Hwy. 199 at Hay's Hill. It is 15 miles from Cave Junction and Grants Pass. Turn on Briggs Valley Road and follow the signs for Big Pine Campground and Onion Mountain.

The road is paved for approximately 15 miles and then becomes a good gravel road. Look for the signs for Sam Brown Campground and adjacent Horse Camp some 4 miles farther, on your left. Elevation is 2,300 feet.
